## TIPS FOR UNDERSTANDING COURSEWORK

**FREE tutoring is a great way to get a step ahead, solidify course concepts, and help achieve success. Other ways to help you succeed at CMCC and beyond include:**

- **FORM a study group.** Study groups help individuals talk through and solidify concepts. You may understand a concept your classmate does not, and vice versa.
- **SHARE notes with classmates.** Find a likeminded classmate, and compare or share notes to ensure you have covered all material.
- **COLLABORATE study tactics and techniques.** This helps you find new ways to learn material, and help other students do the same.
- **TALK to your instructor.** Ask for help, tips, tricks, explanations and for general assistance in learning the course material, or how best to succeed in their class. Know their expectations and learn how to meet them.
- **ADVOCATE for yourself.** This means going a step above and beyond to learn the material, and ensure you know what is expected of you.
